What for? Serious concerns that a child at St Nicholas CE First School is at risk of or currently is in serious harm or danger (i.e. neglect or abuse)

Who to? Miss Parker (Headteacher)

CEOP (Child Exploitation and Online Protection)

What for?

- Someone online has asked me to send them nude images
- I shared a nude image with someone online and they are threatening me
- I did something that I was embarassed about on webcam and someone has turned nasty
- Someone I don't know is asking me to livestream and do things I don't want to do
- Someone online kept asking me to meet them face-to-face and I feel pressured by
- Someone online was talking to me about sex and it made me feel uncomfortable
- Someone online is putting pressure on me to do things I don't want to do
- Someone I met in an online game keeps trying to talk to me privately

Step 1: Go to our closure site https://stnicholas-closure.weebly.com/


Step 2: Click on the 'Safeguarding Link' at the top of the home page

Step 1: Click on the report button






Step 2: Decide whether a report needs to be made
