What for? Serious concerns that a child at St Nicholas CE First School is at risk of or currently is in serious harm or danger (i.e. neglect or abuse)

Who to? Miss Parker (Headteacher)

What for?

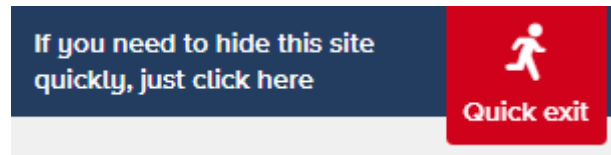
